

24-25-28 Vertical Stripe Scarf



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino [100% merino wool; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #7 brown, 4 skeins [150g]
 - color #6 light beige, 2 skeins [70g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 19cm/7.48"
- length 196cm/77.17"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 26 sts and 23 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

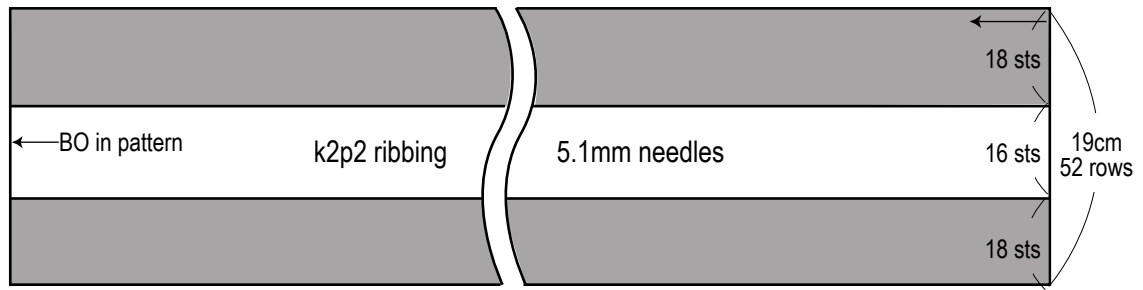
Cast on and work in k2p2 ribbing. Change colors to knit vertical stripes according to schematic. When finished, bind off in pattern. (At each edge, k3 instead of k2).

※This pattern utilizes the intarsia technique. Change colors for stripes starting from the cast-on row. Knit vertical stripes *without* carrying yarn along on the wrong side.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on
