

21-2 Raglan-sleeve Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Silpalon [50% silk, 50% silpalon acrylic; 273 yds/250m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #6119 bronze, 7 cones [350g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½), 3.3mm (approx. US 3), and 3.6mm (approx. US 4) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 48cm/18.90"
- length 56cm/22.05"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 32 rows
- pattern stitch: 27 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※Entire garment worked with yarn held doubled.

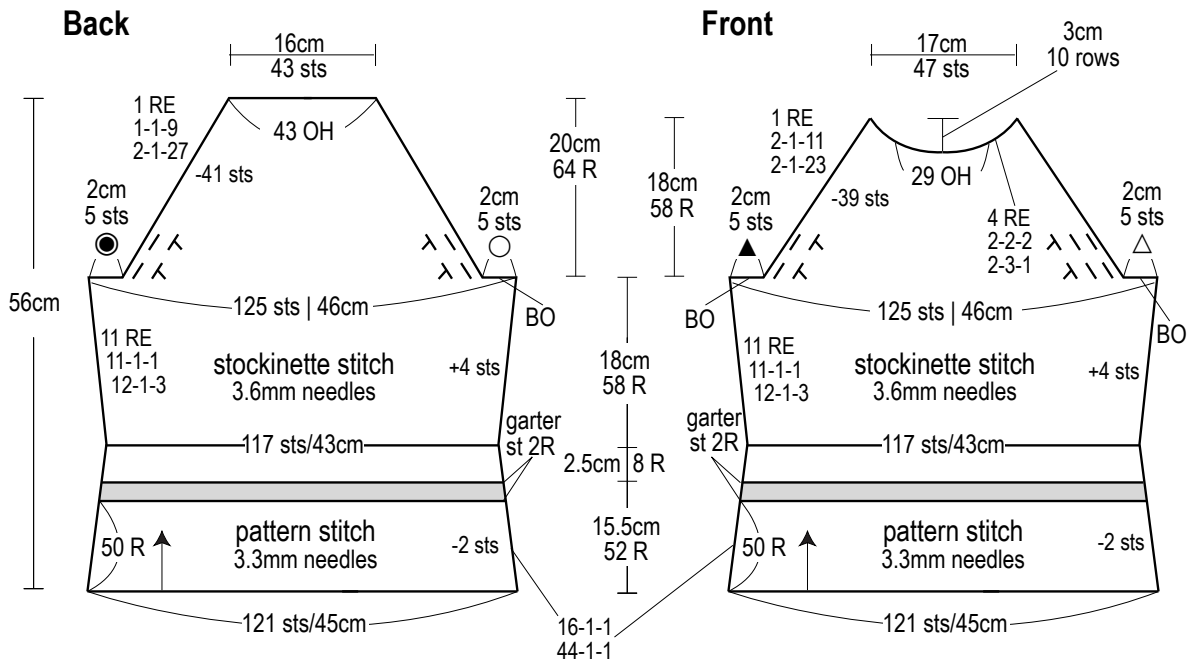
Body: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method and begin working in pattern stitch (k5p3 ribbing). Work 2 rows of garter stitch. Shape raglan edges by binding off stitches where indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (2 stitches in from the edge). (For left front raglan seam *only*, work fully fashioned decreases 3 stitches in from the edge.) Work 2-stitch buttonholes at neckline where indicated. For back neckline, place stitches on hold. For front neckline, shape with short rows.

Sleeve: Work as for body. Shape shoulders by working k2tog or ssk at upper left, upper right.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges, side seams, and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches along neckline and work collar in stockinette stitch, working buttonholes on left front collar as you go. For last two rows, work k1p1 ribbing, then bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method. Pick up live stitches from provisional cast-on edge at cuff and hem; bind off with slip stitch seam from the wrong side.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
OH = on hold (place on stitch holder)
PU = pick up
R = row(s)
RE = row(s) even
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
