

# 27-28-577B Merino Wool Blanket



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Merino Wool [100% wool; 219 yds/200m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #T1 off-white, 3 skeins [100g]
  - color #T3 cream, 5 skeins [200g]
  - color #T5 light mint, 5 skeins [180g]
  - color #T13 orange, 6 skeins [230g]
  - color #T36 red, 2 skeins [65g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle

## Finished measurements:

- 91cm/35.83" square

## Gauge:

- each motif should measure 8cm/3.15" square

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips


※Entire blanket worked with yarn held doubled.

Create magic ring to begin motif A. Ch3 for turning post, dc 2, then repeat \*ch3, dc3\* from \* to \*, working outward to create a square according to schematics. For round 5, work edging as follows: repeat \*ch1, sc1\* from \* to \*. Crochet the required number of motifs A and B, then seam them together with whipstitch. Work 3 rounds around outer edge of blanket. Before seaming motifs together, lightly steam block motifs into shape with an iron to ensure a beautiful finished product.


## Abbreviations:

m = magic ring


### \* Motif A instructions (3.0mm hook)




### \* Motif B instructions (3.0mm hook)




\*Work the fifth round in all motifs in the same color. This will ensure that when you seam them together, they will be uniform and beautiful.



## Edging (3.0mm hook)



## Motif connection instructions (whipstitch)



1. Holding motifs together, thread yarn through back loops with tapestry needle, whipstitching motifs together.

2. Whipstitch in the same manner for vertical seams, but when you reach corners where 4 motifs meet, whipstitch in such a way that you form an X at the corner.
