

212ss-10 Celeste Summer Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Celeste [45% cotton, 40% superwash wool, 15% nylon; 208 yds/190m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #07 peach/khaki/mint, 8 skeins [365g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 46.5cm/18.31"
- length 52cm/20.47"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 26.5 sts and 18.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** The technique used here is often called drop stitch, but it refers specifically to elongated stitches. Also note that the wrong side of the fabric is used as the right side in this garment.

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 4 rows of garter stitch. Continue in pattern stitch. If when working drop stitch, there are too many stitches on the needle, transfer some stitches to new needle. Work 88 rows (22 pattern repeats, each 4 rows), then work 3 rows of garter stitch. Bind off.

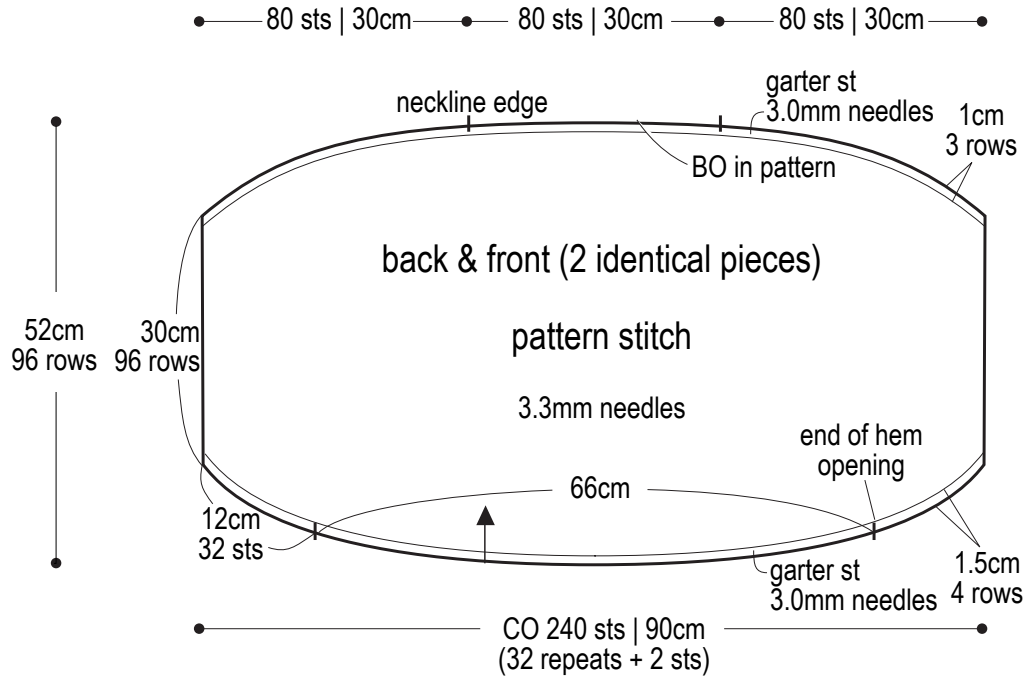
Finishing: Seam shoulders and hem with woven seam (refer to schematics). Pick up 156 stitches around cuff, and work edging in the round. On round 3, work eyelets for drawstring while working in pattern stitch. Bind off in pattern from the wrong side.

Drawstrings: With 2.3mm crochet hook, crochet 2 double chains (each 120cm/47.24" in length). Thread through eyelets in cuffs. Tie each drawstring into a bow however you like.

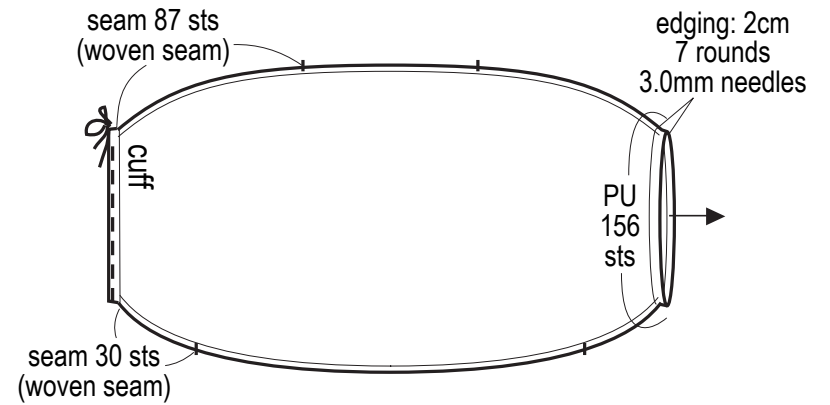

PU = pick up

YO = yarn over

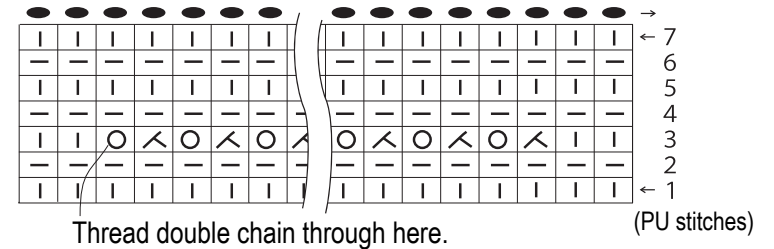

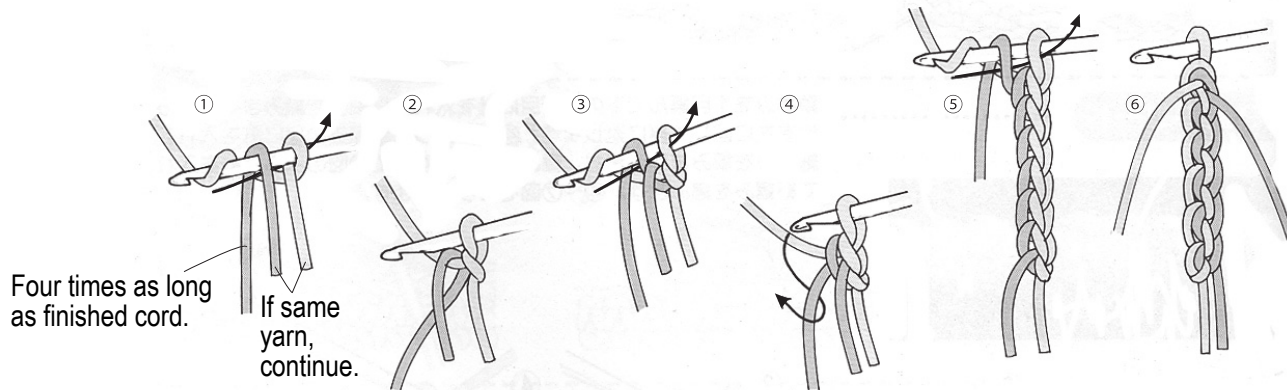
Finishing



Edging (cuff) (3.0mm needles)

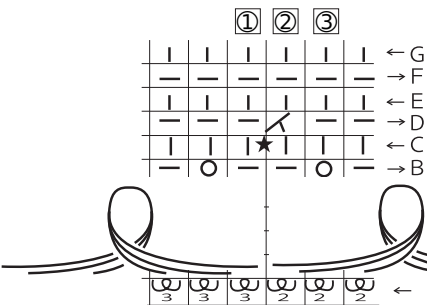
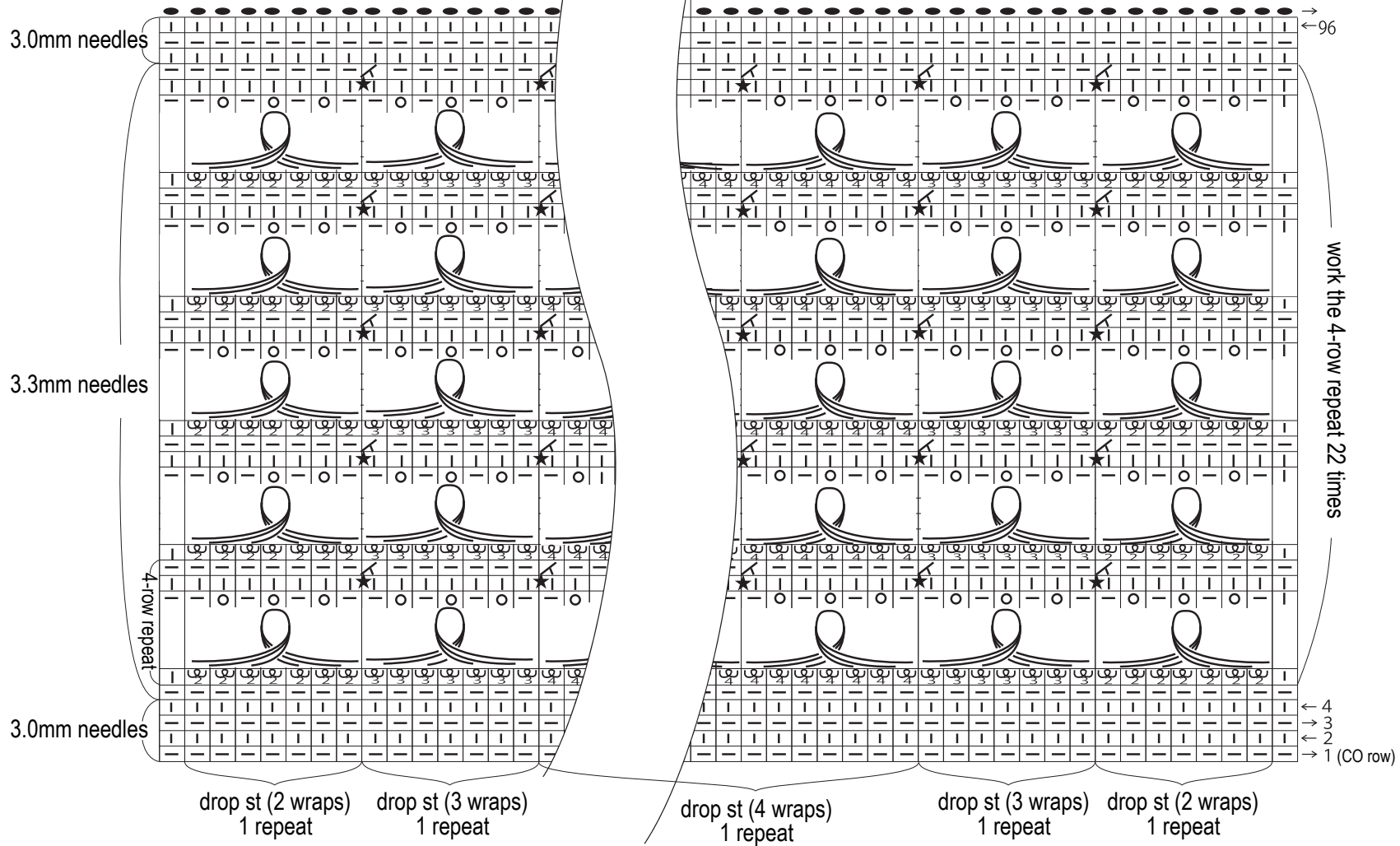


Double chain (2.3mm hook)



※Wrap yarn around hook as if to begin, then also lay another (contrasting) strand of yarn over hook as indicated. Draw hook through loop. Pick up the contrasting strand from opposite side and lay over hook. Draw hook through look as shown in ③. Repeat ④ to ⑤.

Pattern stitch (7-stitch, 4-row repeat)



Pattern stitch tips

- row A: Drop stitches from right side
- row B: Insert needle into stitches dropped from wrong side; k and YO to CO 7 sts
- row C: Work stockinette stitch on right side
- row D: Working on wrong side, insert needle into ★ (the bar between ① and ② on row C) from under row B; stretch out, wrap yarn over left needle, knit together with next stitch (② from row C).
