

212s-9 Brillante Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Oso Blanco Brillante [52% cotton, 28% nylon 20% acrylic; 109 yds/100m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #07 ecru beige, 7 skeins [350g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- center back neck-to-cuff 41.5cm/16.34"
- length 46.5cm/18.31"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Yoke/sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Place marker at each end of neck opening and where sleeves meet body (at armpit area). Bind off in pattern. Yoke/sleeve piece is worked sideways.

Lower front & back body: Pick up stitches from bottom of yoke/sleeve piece. Work front and back, respectively. Bind off in pattern.

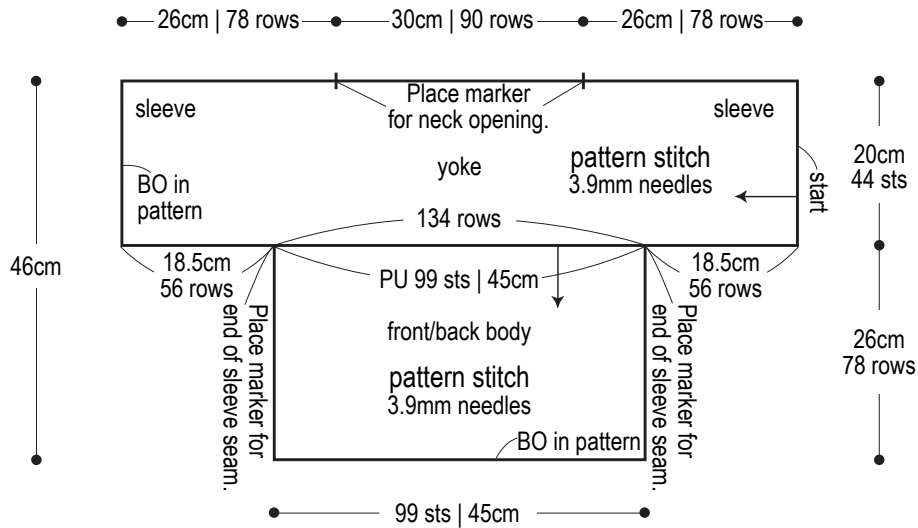
Finishing: Seam shoulders with mattress stitch. Seam sleeve undersides with mattress stitch, continuing seam down sides of garment. Referring to schematic, crochet edging A and B in the round at cuffs, neckline, and hem as indicated.

Abbreviations:

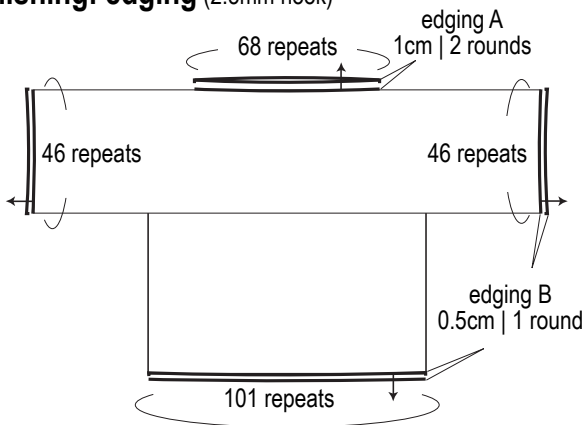
BO = bind off
CO = cast on
PU = pick up

Front/back body * Yoke * Sleeves

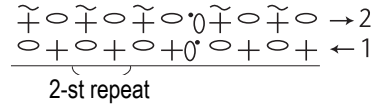
* Measurements reflect garment when laid out flat, not as worn.



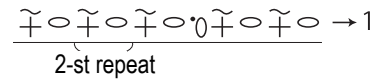
Finishing: edging (2.5mm hook)



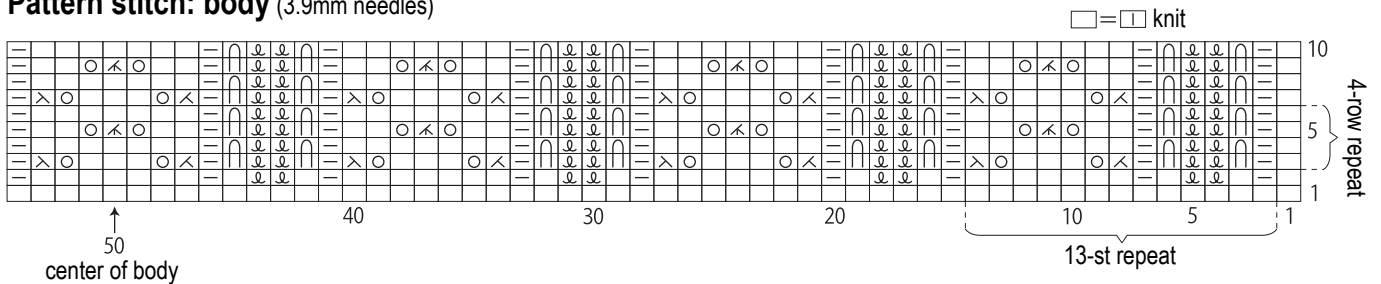
Edging A (2.5mm hook)
