

212s-1 Irish Linen Lacy Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Irish Linen [100% linen; 757 yds/828m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #21 ivory, 3 cones [215g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 45cm/17.72"
- length 53.5cm/21.06"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A, B: 6 peaks and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Front and back body: Work chain to begin, and work first row into bottom loops of chain. Work 2 identical front and back pieces in pattern stitch A and B. Place markers at sleeve area. Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternation slip stitch and chain stitches as needed.)

Sleeve: Working into stitches of sleeve area (marked with stitch markers earlier), work sleeve in pattern stitch B. Starting from row 4, split sleeve at center, working right and left sides separately.


Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides continuously with chain seam (see above). Work edging A in the around at neckline and hem. Work collar with 2.5mm hook. Work edging B in the round around cuff.

Abbreviations:


ch = chain

pm = place marker


Front & back body




Sleeve




Front & back body instructions (3.0mm hook)
