

210-8 Silpalon French Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Silpalon [50% silk, 50% silpalon acrylic; 273 yds/250m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #6124 imperial blue, 2 cones [85g]
- Pierrot Yarns Kirara [89% acetate, 11% polyester; 1892 yds/1730m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #4806 light pink silver lamé, 1 cone [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 46cm/18.11"
- length 45.5cm/17.91"

Gauge:

- each motif should measure 15cm/5.91" square

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together: 1 strand of Silk Silpalon and 1 strand of Kirara.

Body: Chain 5 stitches and join into the round. Referring to chart, work motif. Starting from second motif, seam motifs together on the last round. (Be sure to leave armhole openings unseamed.)


Finishing: Work 1 round of edging around armholes and neckline.

Abbreviations:


rep = repeat(s)

3.0mm hook




Motif seaming




* Slip stitch motif to adjoining motif where marked with ● .

Front & back body




Collar & cuff edging
