#### Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orange [100% merino wool; 175 yds/160m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
  - color #01 pink/beige, 1 skein [5g]
  - color #03 red/blue/yellow/green, 1 skein [7g]
  - · color #05 green/blue/brown, 1 skein [10g]
- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso [100% wool (50% merino); 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #301 off-white, 1 skein [5g]
  - color #306 red, 1 skein [5g]
  - color #314 cvan green & color #324 sunflower, 1 skein each [small amount]
- Pierrot Yarns Zakka Natural Series ZA-R-4 [100% kenaf; 66 yds/60m per 3.53 oz./100g skein]; undyed, 1 skein [1.2 meters]

#### **Tools/Notions:**

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- felting needles
- Pierrot Yarns Felt Hitsuji-chan [100% merino wool roving]; 25g per package
  - color 1 off-white; 3 packages [65g]
  - colors 3 orange, 9 sky blue, 11 yellow, & 13 red; 1 package each [small amount]
- small amount polyfiber stuffing
- 6 safety eyes (4mm/0.16")
- 6 twigs (for arms of snowmen)

### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

No gauge information is provided in the original pattern.

### Crochet/Knitting/Felting Tips

**Snowman:** Divide Felt Hitsuji-chan for head and body; form into balls as shown in diagrams. Place head on top of body and fasten them together where they come in contact using felting needles. Use scissors to cut a notch for the nose, insert nose, and fasten to head with felting needles. Attach eyes and twig arms with glue. Add pink color to cheeks with rouge or colored pencil.

**Hats:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work stockinette stitch in the round. Thread yarn through remaining stitches; cinch top of hat shut. Attach pompom to the top of Snowman C's hat.

**Scarves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work in stockinette stitch. Bind off in pattern.

**Heart:** Create magic ring; crochet bottom of heart while increasing as indicated. Crochet left and right upper pieces, respectively, then insert stuffing. Crochet a loop and fasten to heart.

**Wreath:** Create magic ring; begin working in the round without a turning post. Crochet wreath, then whipstitch beginning to end. Glue decorative balls made of Felt Hitsuji-chan to surface of wreath. Wind gold thread around wreath, then tie into a bow.

**Stocking:** Chain to begin; work sc in the round. Work heel back-and-forth in rows. On ninth row, resume working in the round. When finished, thread yarn through remaining stitches and cinch the toe shut..

Star: Needle-felt Felt Hitsuji-chan roving into star shape. (Use of a star-shaped mold or cookie cutter is recommended.) Glue on sequins.

Gift: Create a box-shaped mold using cardboard. Felt the Felt-Hitsuji-chan roving using this mold, adding soapy water to help felt.

Finishing: Cut a piece of kenaf yarn to desired length. Thread heart, star, wreath, stocking, and gift ornaments on this strand of yarn.

ch = chain CO = cast on DPNs = double-pointed knitting needles m = magic ring sc = single crochet (US)

### **Snowman instructions**

#### Snowman A Snowman B, C Attach eyes -16cm (4mm/0.16") with glue. #### 1. Divide the Felt Hitsuji-chan roving.



Use 3/4 of the roving to begin. With your hands, gently pull apart the roving to loosen it up.

#### 2. Prick the roving with the felting needle.



Shape the roving by pricking it repeatedly with the felting needle.

\*For safety's sake, please use a felting mat.



#### 3. Cover with a thin layer of roving to neaten the outer appearance.



Rough outer surface.


Lightly loosen the remaining 1/4 of the roving by hand. Wrap around felt ball as desired. Lightly felt.

With the thin outer layer now attached, the surface beautifully smooth.

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
### Hats (3.3mm DPNs)

\*Knit each hat with 2 strands of Junmo Chuboso held together.




# Scarf (3.3mm needles)


\*Knit each scarf with 2 strands of Junmo Chuboso held together.



### **Heart** (3.0mm hook) Orange, color #01 pink/beige









### **Stocking**


Junmo Chuboso, color #314 cyan green Junmo Chuboso, color #324 sunflower

\*Always work Junmo Chuboso with 2 strands of yarn held together.





Make a box-shaped mold using cardboard.
