

213w-22 Momo Little Dress



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Momo-little [100% extra fine merino wool; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #01 white, 4 skeins [110g]
 - color #10 ivy gray, 3 skeins [80g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- chest 66cm/25.98"
- cross back width 26.5cm/10.43"
- length 49.5cm/19.49"
- sleeve length 8.5cm/3.35"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 25 sts and 37 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Skirt: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 6 rows of garter stitch, then continue in stockinette stitch. Work decreases on last row.

Bodice: Work in stripes, alternating between ivy gray and white every 2 rows. Shape armscye and neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at edges.

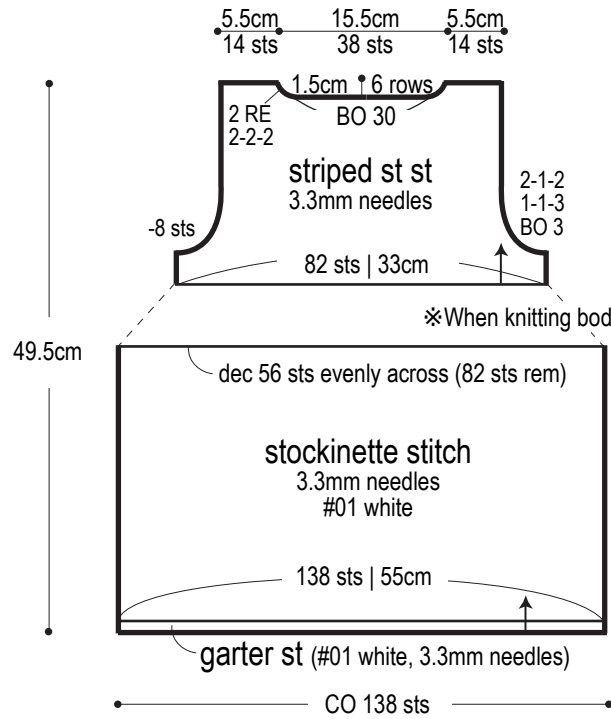
Sleeves: Start as for skirt, work in garter stitch, then work stripes as for bodice.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in garter stitch. Bind off loosely. Seam sleeves to bodice with crochet slip stitch seam.

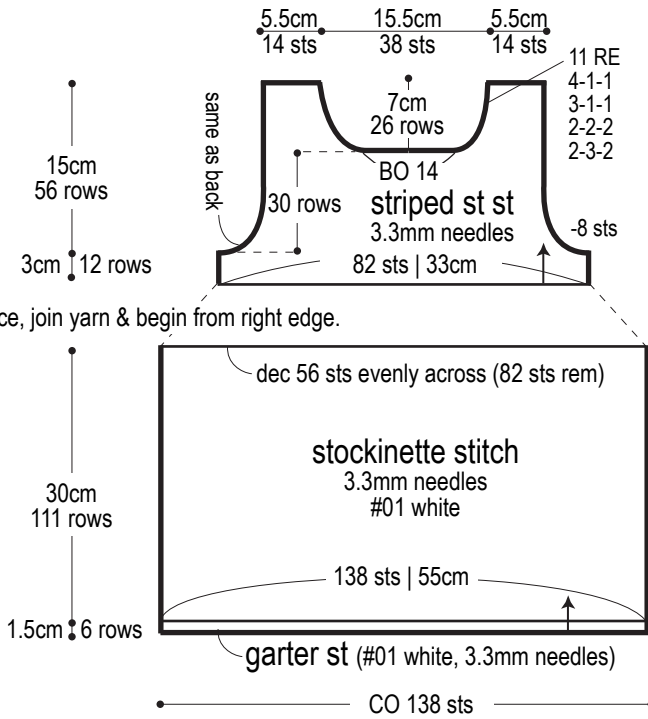
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on PU = pick up RE = row(s) even RS = right side #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

*When knitting bodice, join yarn & begin from right edge.

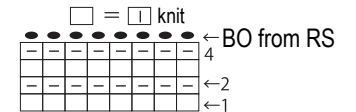
Finishing: neckline

garter stitch, 3.0mm DPNs

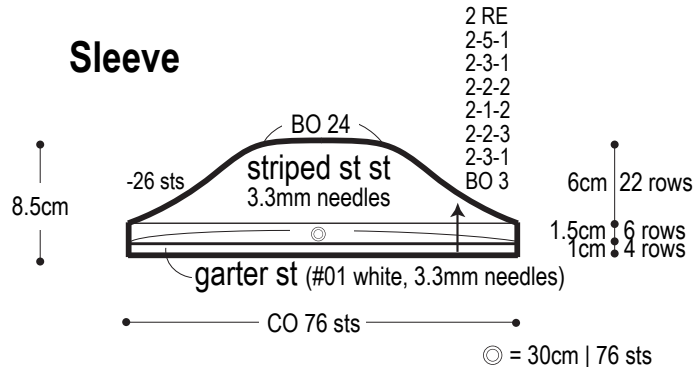


Collar: garter stitch

#01 white, 3.0mm DPNs

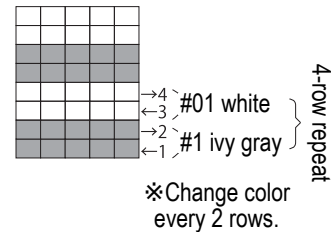


Sleeve
