26-27-4 Pullover



Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Basic Alpaca Namibuto [50% wool, 50% alpaca; 107 yds/98m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #35, 9 skeins [360g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) double-pointed or circular knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- · chest 106cm/41.73"
- cross back width 47cm/18.50"
- back length 66cm/25.98"
- sleeve length 59cm/23.23"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 18 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing followed by pattern stitch (refer to schematic). Bind off stitches to shape armhole. Shape neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at neckline edges. Shapes sides of sleeve with backwards loop cast-on method. When finished working sleeve, do not bind them off; place all the stitches remaining (the sleeve cap) on at stitch holder.

Finishing: Seam shoulders together with three-needle bind-off method. Sean sleeves to body with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar edging in k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off collar stitches, then fold collar in half (to the inside of the garment). Tack collar down with whipstitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides in one continuous mattress stitch seam (per side).

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit


OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

p = purl


PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even


