

214ss-23 Suspender Skirt



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Framboise [70% cotton, 25% acrylic, 5% nylon; 120 yds/110m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #6 framboise, 6 skeins [230g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (13mm/0.51")

Finished measurements:

- chest 55cm/21.65"
- skirt length 34cm/13.39"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 23 sts and 36 rows
- pattern stitch B: 22.5 sts and 20 rows
- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Skirt: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A and stockinette stitch. For front of skirt only, work right and left sides separately starting from the beginning of the split for the buttonband onward. Seam sides with mattress stitch.

Belt: Working into stitches along front and back of skirt, crochet belt in pattern stitch B.

Finishing: Work buttonband in pattern stitch C, working buttonholes in upper buttonband only. Crochet suspender straps and seam in place as indicated in finishing schematic.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch CO = cast on k = knit p = purl sc = single crochet (US) sc2tog = work 2 sc stitches together
