

214w-21 Ribbed Cap



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Giselle [80% merino, 20% nylon; 83 yds/76m per 1.41 oz/40g skein];
 - one of the following:
 - color #01 cobalt, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #02 navy, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #03 maple leaf, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #04 thyme, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #05 raspberry pink, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #06 cinnamon, 3 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 46cm/18.11"
- height (with brim folded up) 23cm/9.06"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- k2p2 ribbing: 19 sts and 26.5 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

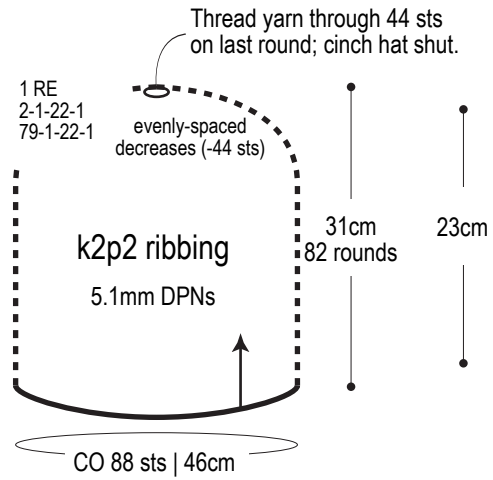
Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work k2p2 ribbing in the round with no increases or decreases for 78 rounds. Begin working decreases on round 79. After last round, cut yarn and thread tail through all remaining stitches. Cinch top of hat shut.

Abbreviations:

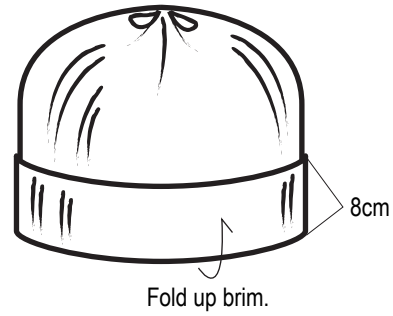
CO = cast on k = knit p = purl RE = round(s) even

= rounds-stitches-places-times [for evenly spaced decreases across entire width of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 round, decrease 2 stitches in each of 3 places across the round; do this 4 times total."
