

373so Aran Socks



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urban [100% merino wool; 394 yds/360m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #01 off-white, 2 skeins [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- foot length 23cm/9.06"
- mouth of sock 21cm/8.27"
- length of sock 30.5cm/12.01"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 38 sts and 41 rows
- stockinette stitch: 28 sts and 41 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖**Note 1:** each sock worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

❖**Note 2:** The foot is designed somewhat smaller than the stated foot length to account for stretching. (That is, it has negative ease.)

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round to begin working from the cuff downward. Work in k1p1 ribbing in the round, then pattern stitch. Continue, working 16 rounds with instep side in pattern stitch and sole side in stockinette stitch. While working heel, place instep stitches on hold. Work heel section in stockinette stitch back and forth in rows according to chart.

Join yarn to center of sole where indicated. Work foot in the round as follows: work sole in stockinette stitch, and work instep by continuing pattern stitch from stitches on hold. Work toe in stockinette stitch in the round, working decreases to shape toe according to chart. When finished, seam toe with Kitchener stitch.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

k = knit

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together

p = purl

OH = on hold (that is, on stitch holder)

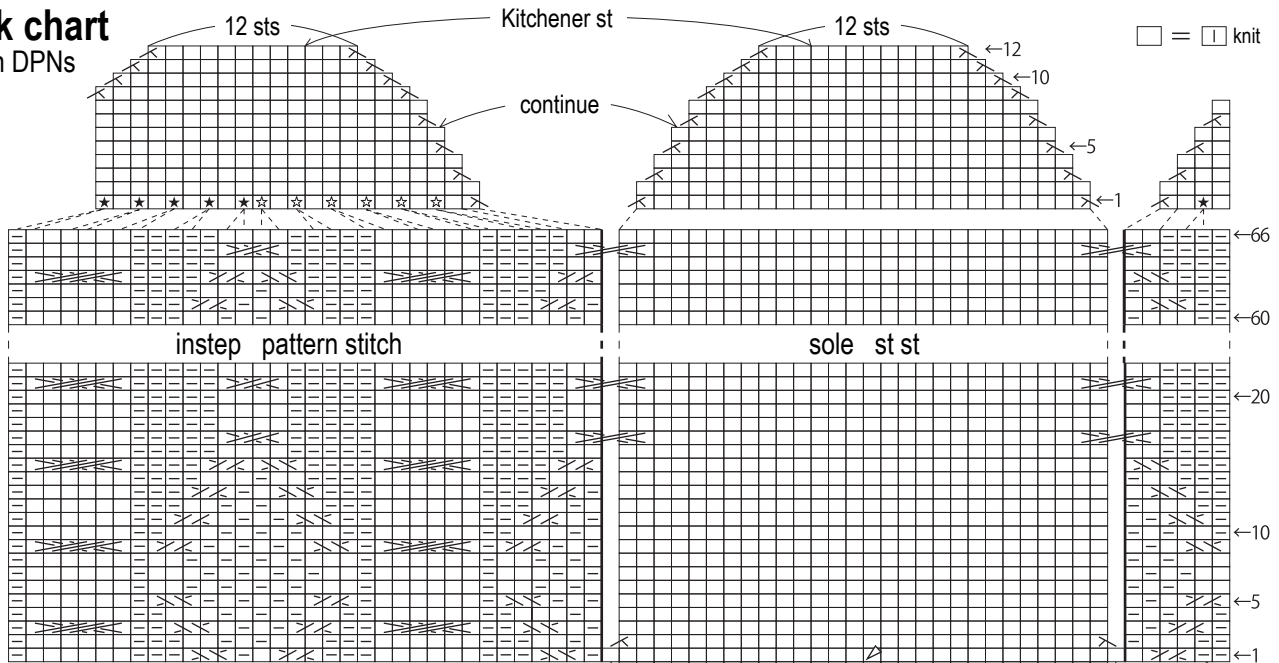
RE = row(s) even

ssk = slip, slip, knit

= rows-stitches-times

2.7mm DPNs



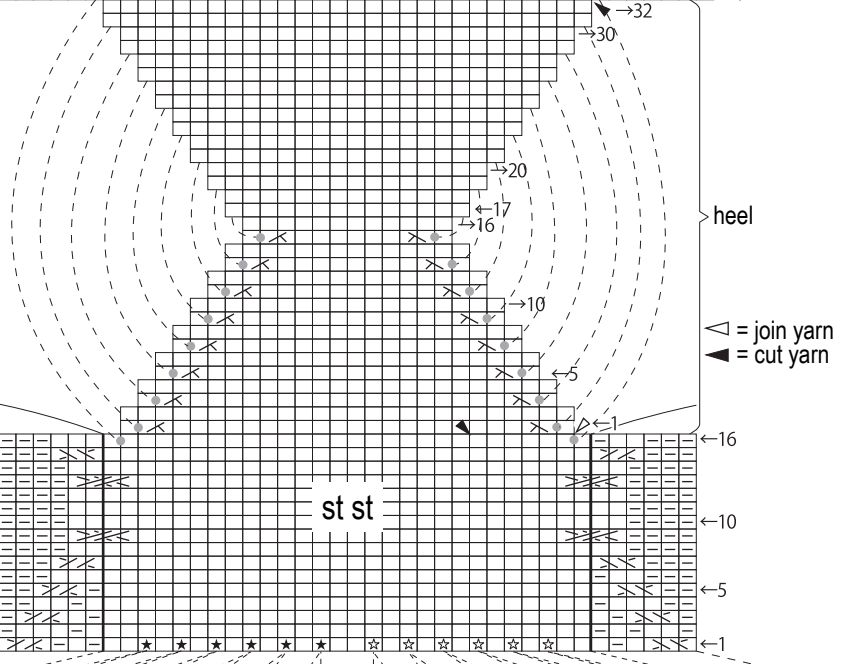
□ = 1 knit

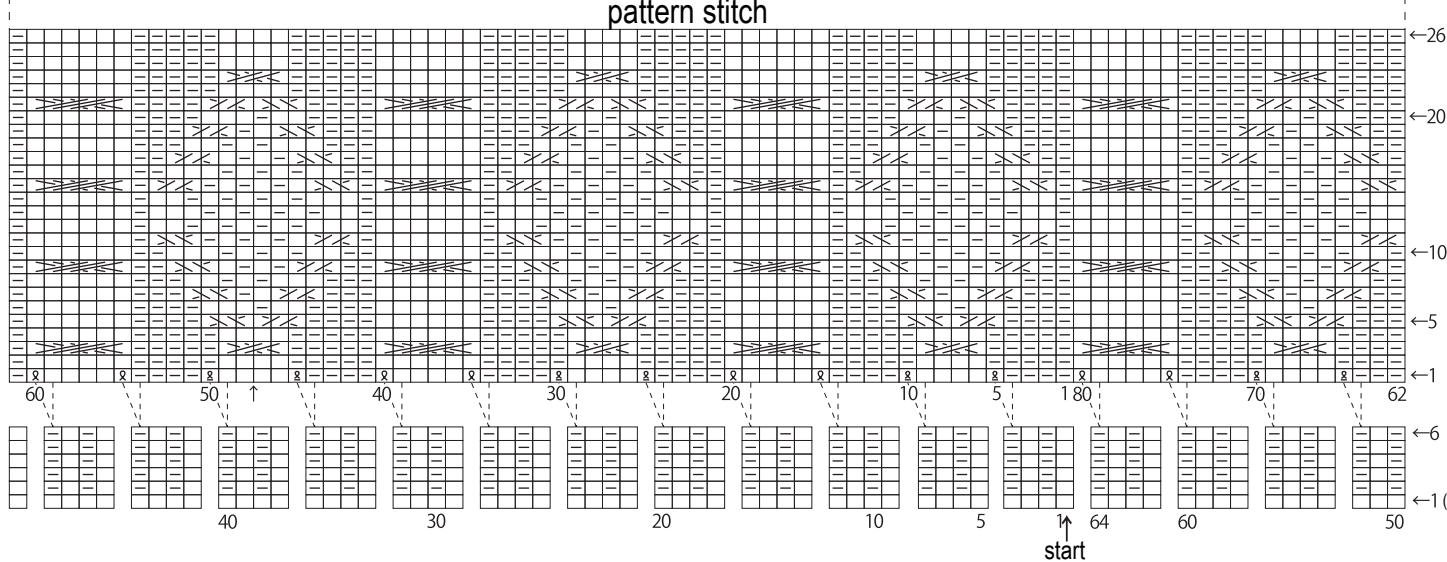
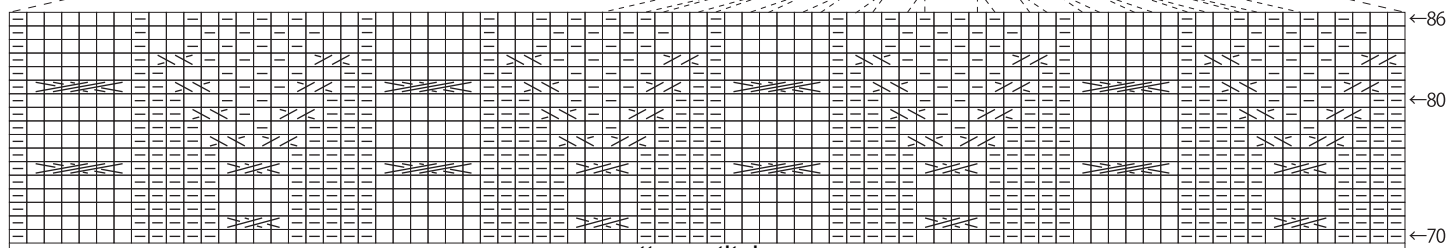
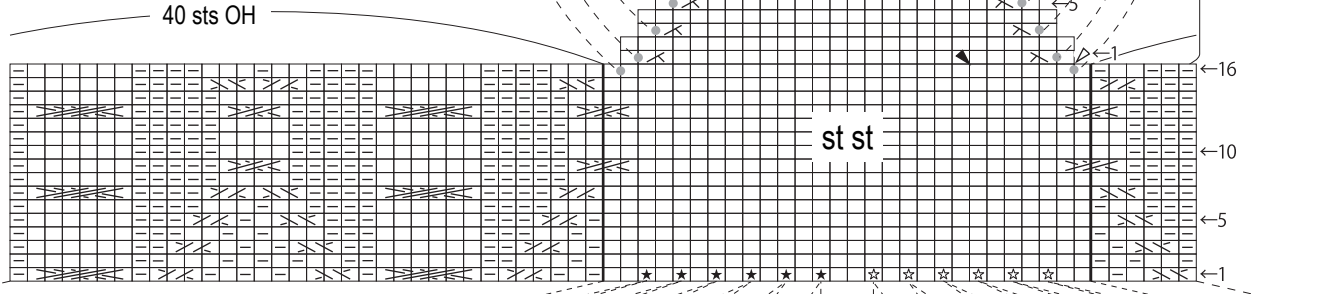
