

# Atelier Wool Cardigan



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Atelier Wool [100% wool; 69 yds/63m per 1.41oz/40g skein]; color #63 berry, 16 skeins [620g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.5mm (US 7) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (45mm/1.77")
- 3 buttons (21mm/0.83")

## Finished measurements:

- back length 53cm/20.87"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 17 sts and 23 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 12 rows of edging, then continue in stockinette stitch. For front pieces, work buttonband in k1p1 ribbing at the same time as you work the rest of the front. Work buttonholes in right front buttonband only. Work collar in stockinette stitch and then edging stitch. Bind off.

**Finishing:** Seam sides from 1) cuff to end of collar and 2) hem to cuff with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around cuff and work edging in the round.

## Abbreviations:

blco = backwards loop cast-on

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

inc = increase

k = knit

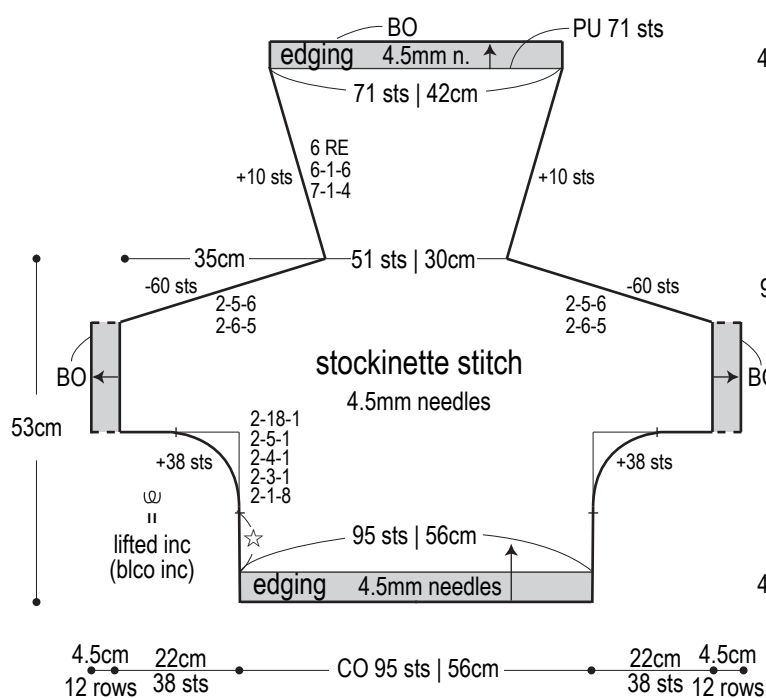
p = purl

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

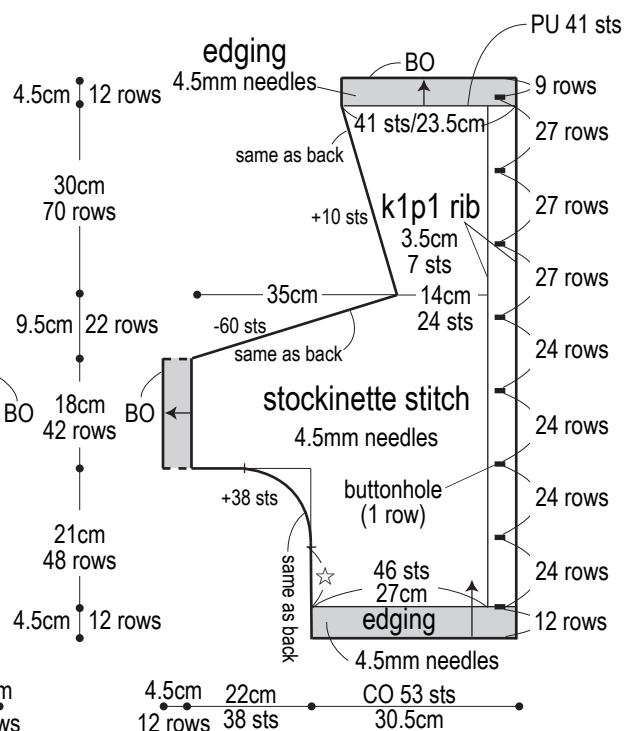
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

### Right front

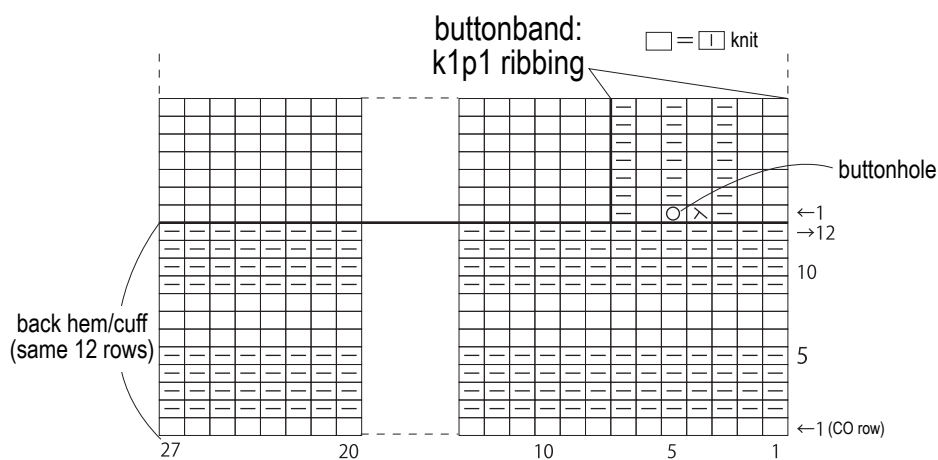
※Reverse shaping for left front.
