

# 368socks Friends Socks



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Friends [65% wool, 35% acrylic; 186 yds/170m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #03 rose pink, 2 skeins [80g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.4mm (approx. US 1) and 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- foot length 23cm/9.06"
- mouth of sock (circumference) 23cm/9.06"
- sock length 35.5cm/13.98"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 37 rounds
- pattern stitch: 28 sts and 40 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work 7 rounds of k1p1 ribbing, then 104 rounds of pattern stitch, then 15 rounds of stockinette stitch. Continue, placing 27 stitches on stitch holder. Work remaining 27 stitches of heel back and forth in rows according to schematic. When heel is complete, pick up 27 stitches from stitch holder and begin working stockinette stitch in the round again. Shape toe by working decreases as indicated. Seam toe with Kitchener stitch.

✳️**Note:** The foot is designed somewhat smaller than the stated foot length to account for stretching. (That is, it has negative ease.)

## Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

DPNs = double-pointed needles

k = knit

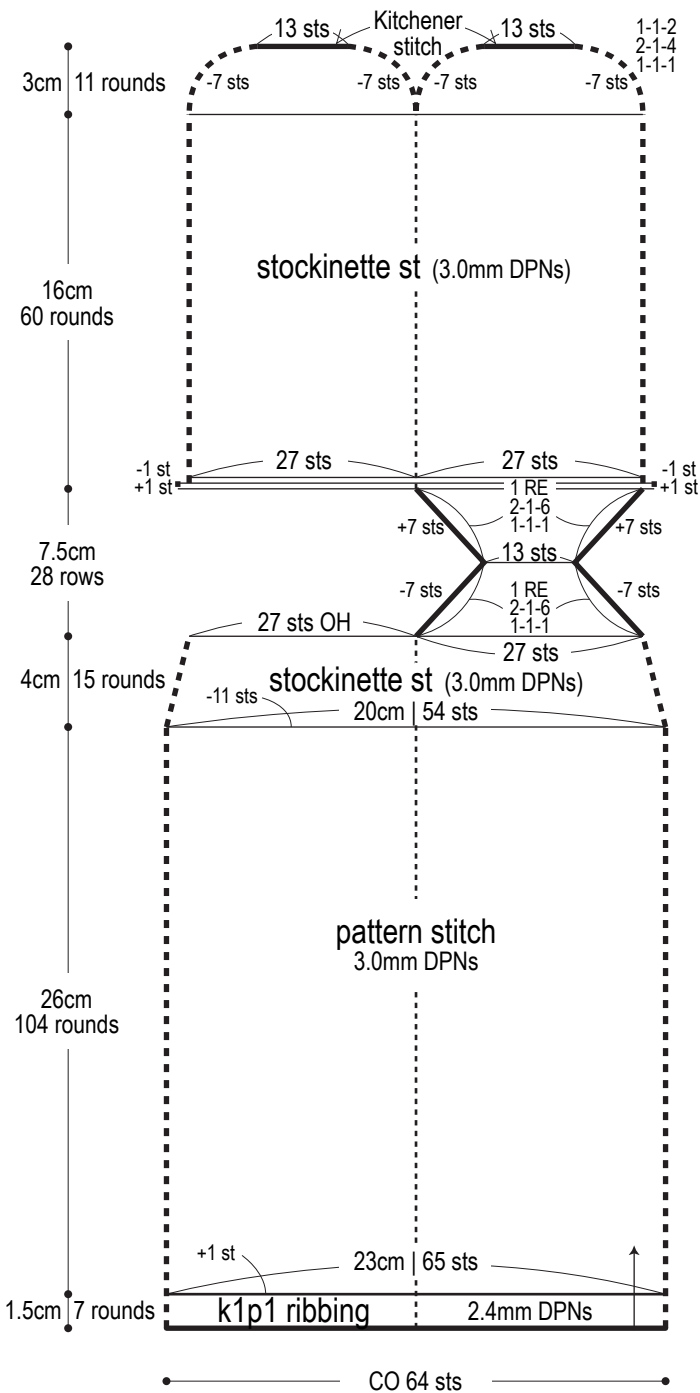
OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder)

p = purl

RE = row(s) even

# # # = rows-stitches-times

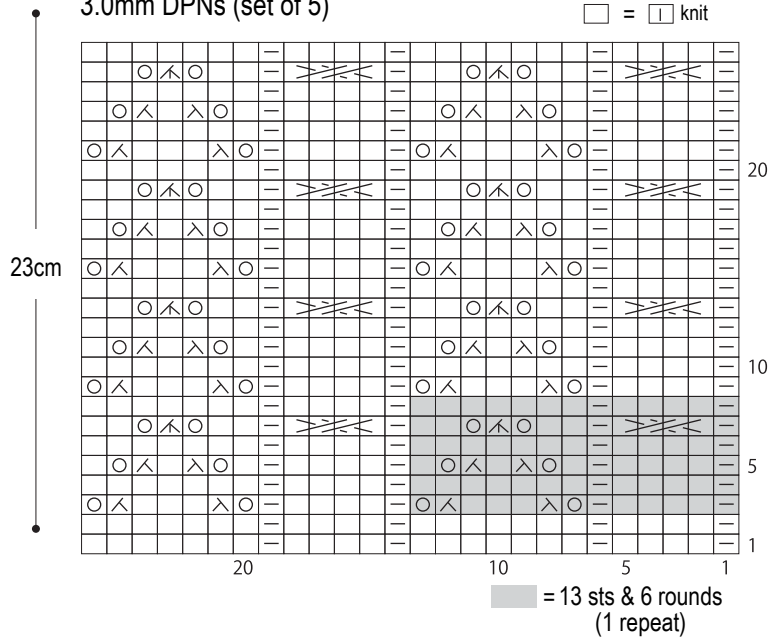
# Sock schematic



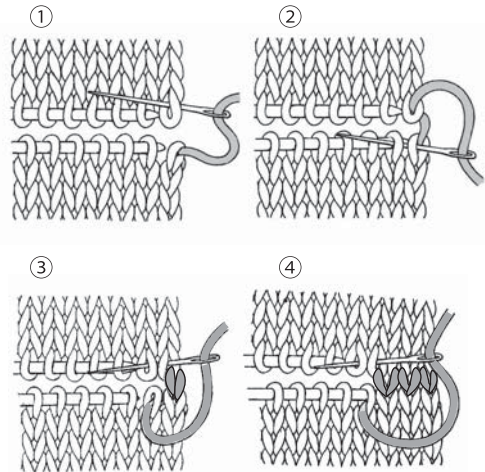
## Pattern stitch

□ = □ knit



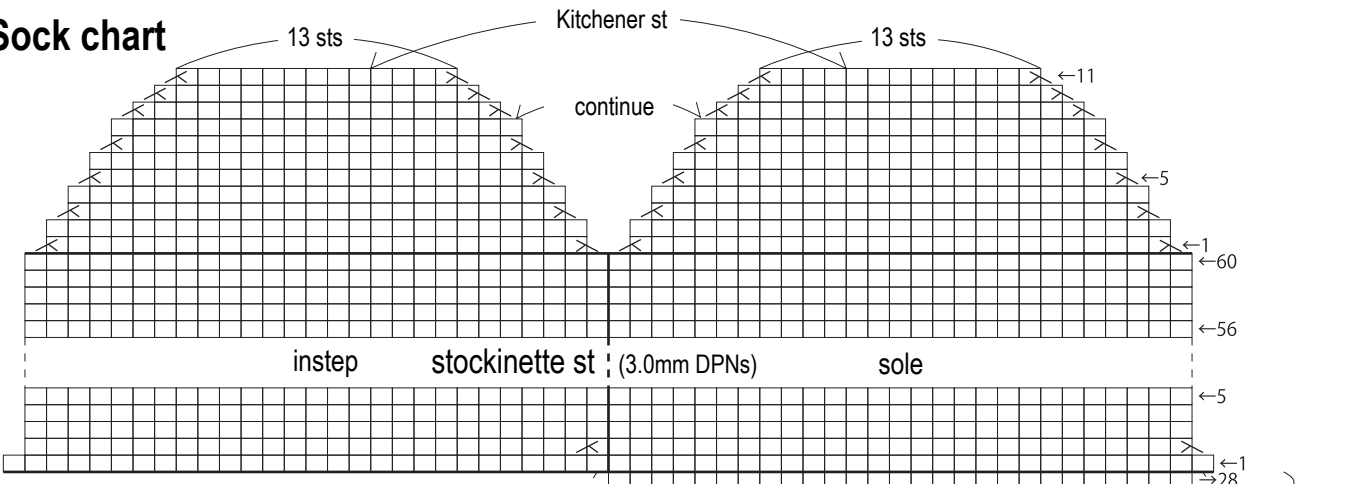
## Kitchener stitch

# Sock chart



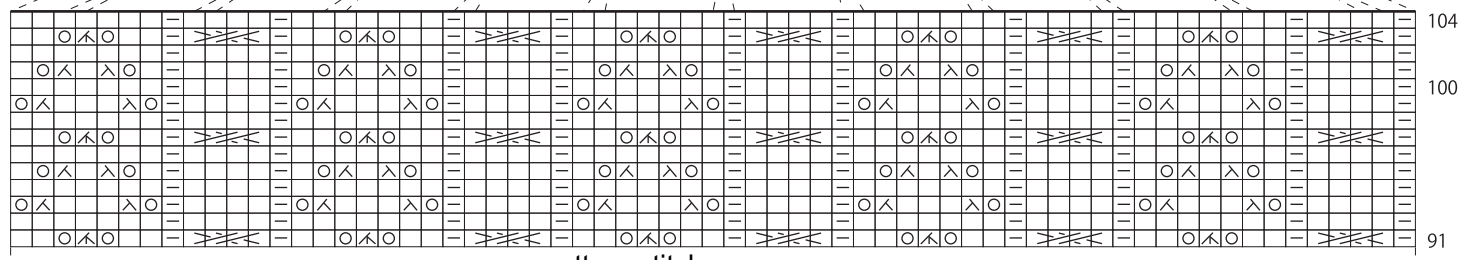
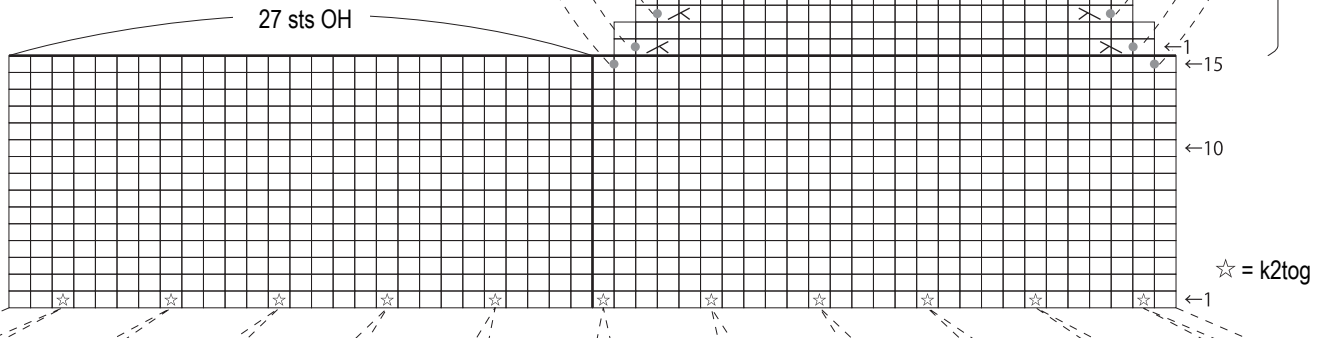
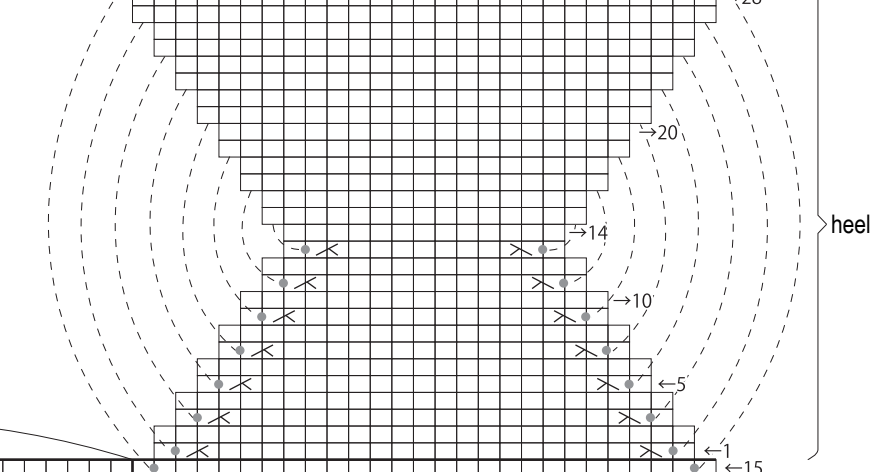

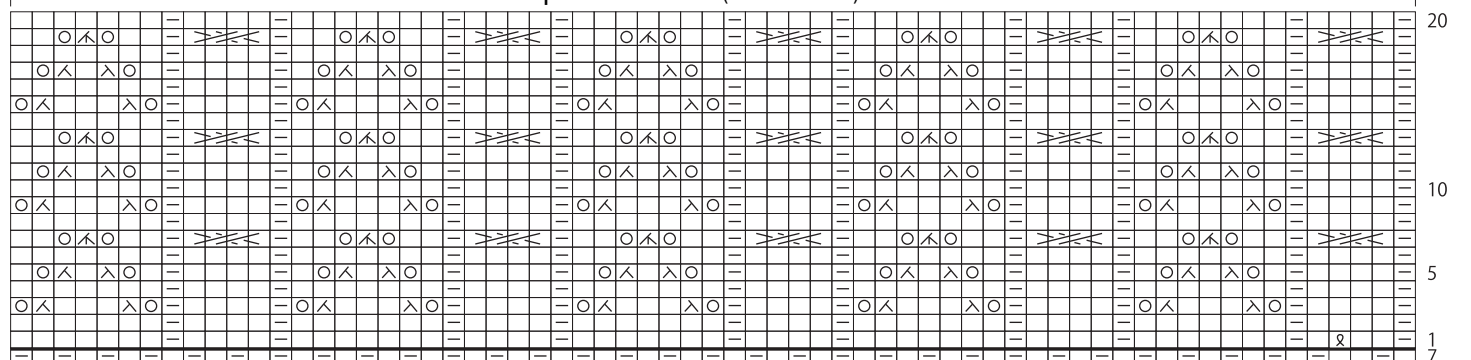
