fz119-1 Azayaka Cowl



Suggested yarn:

Keito-Zakka Stores New Cotton Baby [100% cotton; 93 yds/85m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
color #10 flamingo, 4 skeins [85g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 30cm/11.81"
- circumference 75cm/29.53"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 25.5 sts and 13 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

*Note: Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Cowl: Work foundation chain to begin. Work in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam foundatin chain edge to bind-off edge with right sides facing each other using chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern).

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
