z724-5 Cowl



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Merino Warm Fingering [50% merino wool, 50% wool; 164 yds/150m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #21 off-white, 1 skein [25g]
- Keito-Zakka Stores Merisilk [80% merino wool, 20% silk; 273 yds/250m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #8 love peach, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

• 3.6mm (approx. US 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 67cm/26.38"
- · width 26.5cm/10.43"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 20 sts and 43 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

Body of cowl: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in reverse stockinette stitch, then pattern stitch, then reverse stockinette stitch. For pattern stitch, in order to change color every row, you will need to change direction of work, so we recommend using double-pointed needles. Bind off tightly.

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Finishing: With wrong sides facing, seam side edges with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

RS = right side
