

365snood Momo Little Cowl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Momo Little [100% merino wool; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #05 sumile, 5 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 23.5cm/9.25"
- length 120cm/47.24"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 27 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

✳️**Note:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

Cowl: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch. Bind off.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam foundation chain edge to bind-off edge using whipstitch. Work edging in the round around each edge.

ch = chain
