

# 217w-09 Openwork Slouch Socks



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Chameleon Camera [75% wool, 25% nylon; 459 yds/420m per 3.53 oz./100g skein];
  - color #101 Off-white, 1 skein [80g]
  - color #105 Viridian, 1 skein [5g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

## Finished measurements:

- foot length 23cm/9.06"
- mouth of sock 21cm/8.27"
- sock height 27cm/10.63"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 28 sts and 38 rounds
- pattern stitch: 32 sts and 38 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*



## Summary

**Sock (make 2):** With color #101 off-white, cast on with long-tail cast-on method and join into the round. Work 6 rounds of k1p1 ribbing to form the cuff. Continue in pattern stitch and st st. Work heel in color #105 viridian as shown in schematic and chart. Work from heel to toe in pattern stitch (instep) and st st (sole). Work toe in color #105 viridian. Graft toe with Kitchener stitch.

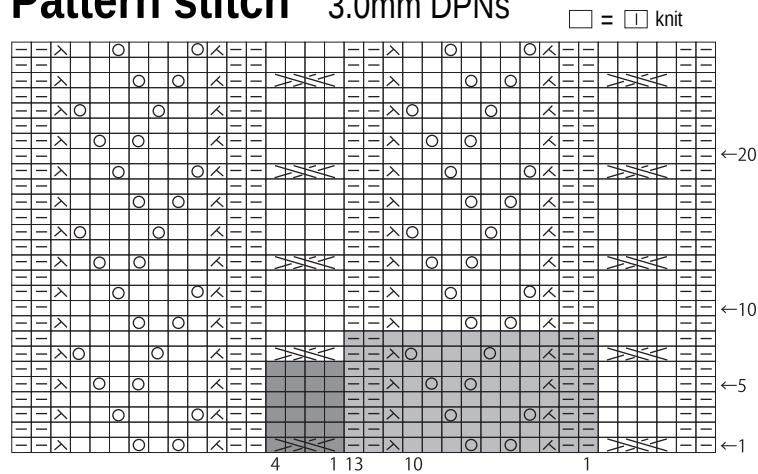
## Abbreviations:

C4F = slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work; k2, k2 from cable needle  
CO = cast on  
k = knit  
k2tog = knit 2 together  
OH = on hold (place on st holder)  
p = purl  
RE = row(s) even  
ssk = slip, slip, knit  
st st = stockinette stitch  
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

# Sock schematic 3.0mm DPNs

\*Work heel & toe in color #105 viridian. Use color #101 off-white for everything else.

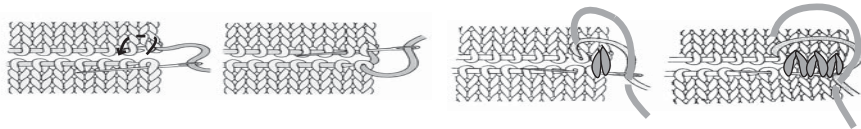
## Pattern stitch 3.0mm DPNs



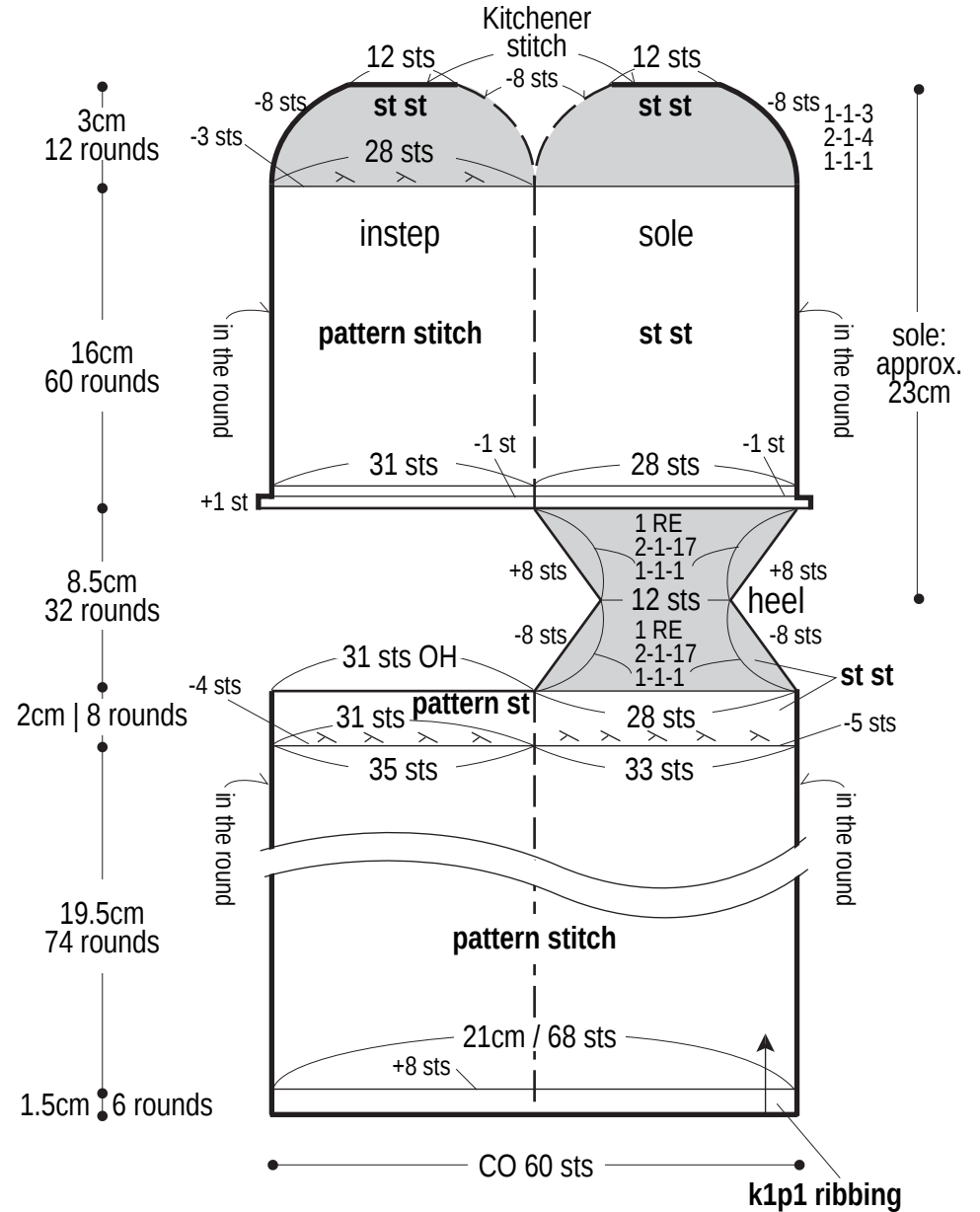
■ = 4-st, 6-row repeat    ■ = 13-st, 8-row repeat

## Kitchener stitch

- ① Insert needle into stitch at edge.
- ② Insert needle through sts as shown by arrow in step ①.
- ③ Insert needle into edge st and st next to it.
- ④ Repeat steps ② to ③.



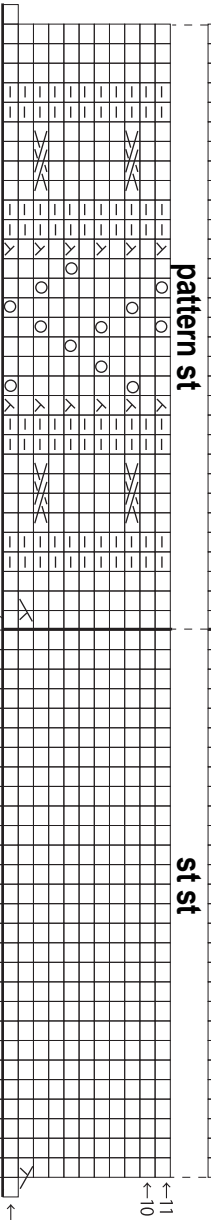
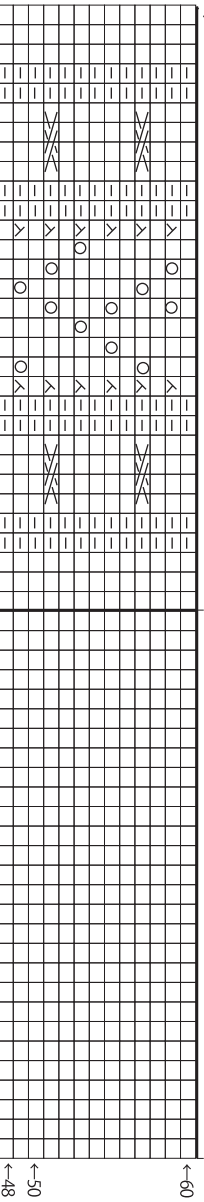
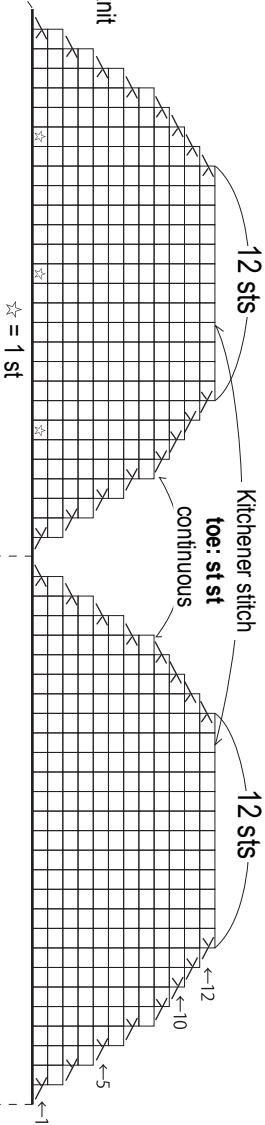
\*Align stitches of knitted fabric. Graft together by linking each stitch to the ones below it, forming a row of knit stitches as you go.
