

# 1234mf Julika Mohair Scarf



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Julika [51% mohair, 34% nylon,, 15% merino wool; 378 yds/346m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #03 very berry, 4 skeins [100g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- width 27cm/10.63"
- length 160cm/62.99"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 26.5 sts and 10 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖**Note 1:** Like all Japanese patterns, stitch counts given here for foundation chains do not include any chain sts needed for turning posts.

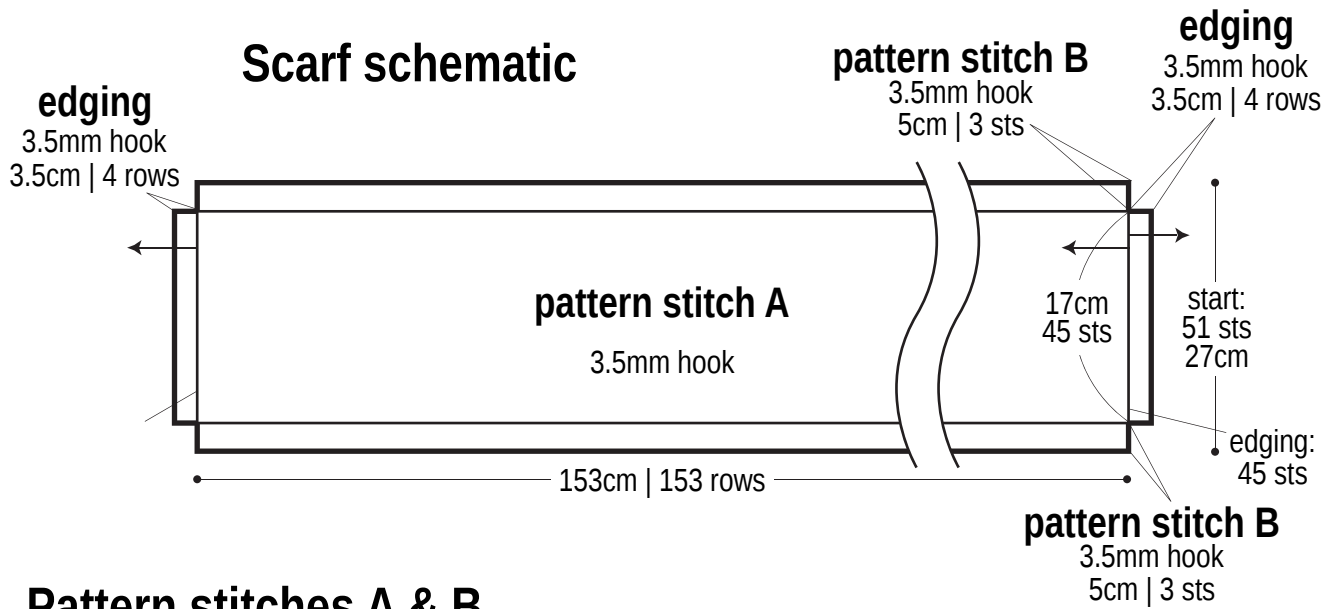
❖**Note 2:** Entire item worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Work foundation chain to begin, then work body of scarf in pattern stitches A & B (see schematic & chart). Work edging along short ends.

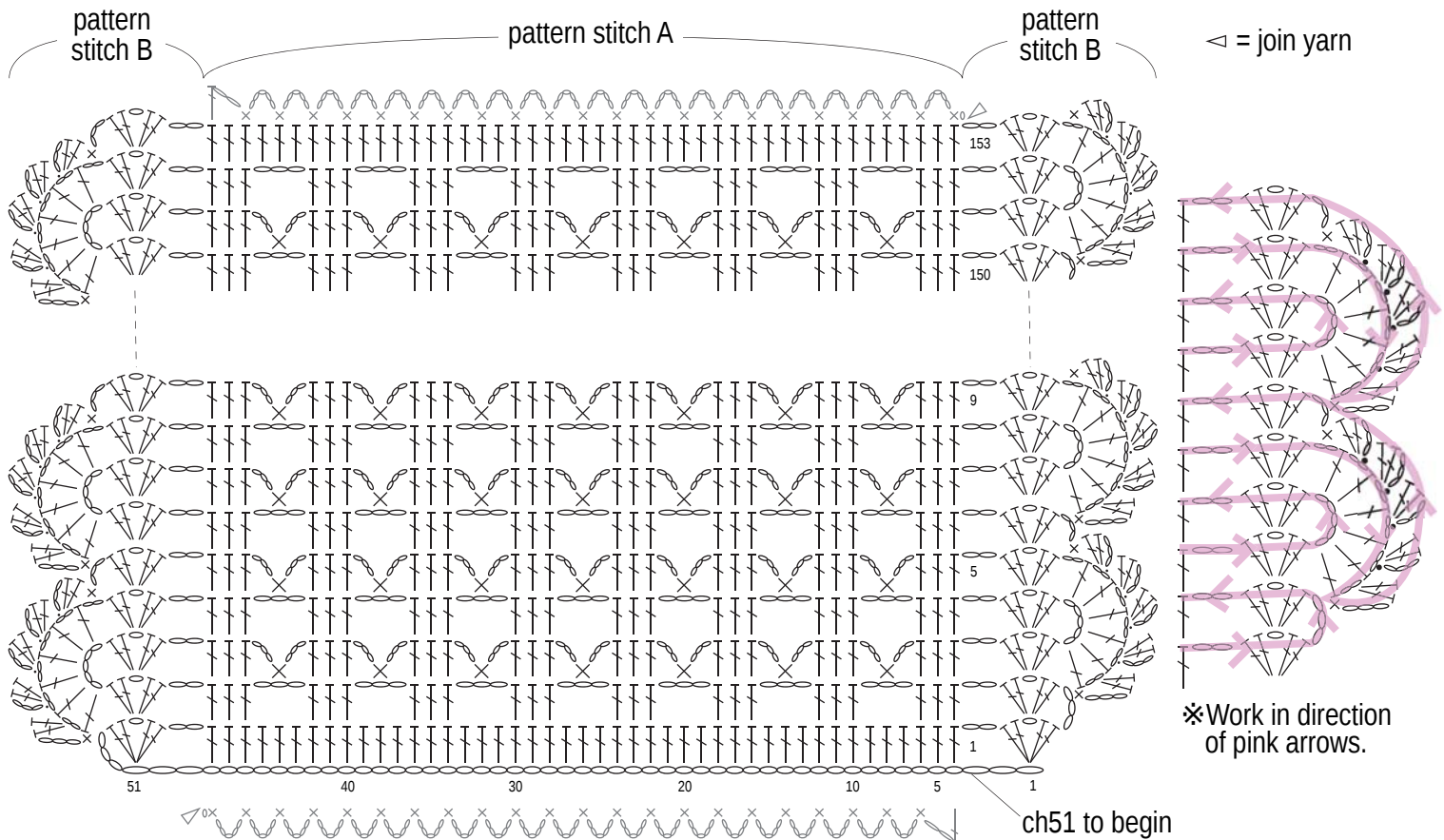
