

# tricot14-1 Cowl



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Smooth Silk Wool [80% merino wool, 20% silk; 120 yds/110m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #5 bordeaux, 5 skeins [145g]
- Keito-Zakka Stores Princess Lily [40% merino wool, 60% wool; 175 yds/160m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #01 cream white, 2 skeins [80g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- Please see finishing schematic.

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 5.1mm needles): 19.5 sts and 34 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Summary

❖**Note:** entire item worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

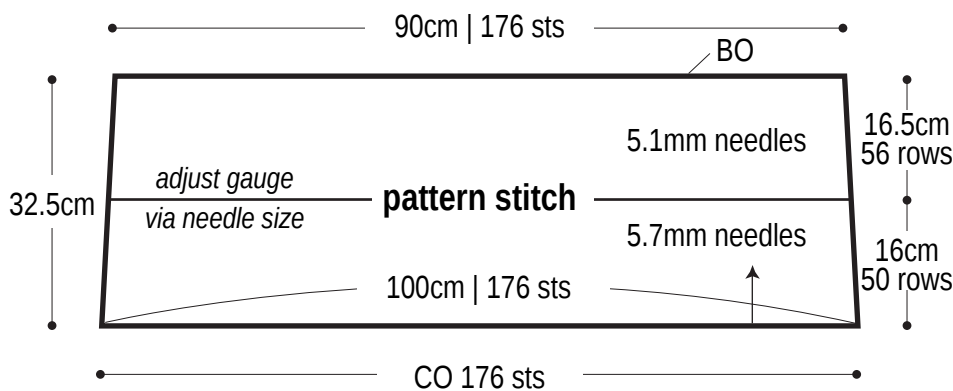
**Body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch, changing needle size where indicated to adjust gauge. Bind off.

**Finishing:** Seam short ends together with mattress stitch after making one complete twist in the fabric (see finishing schematic).

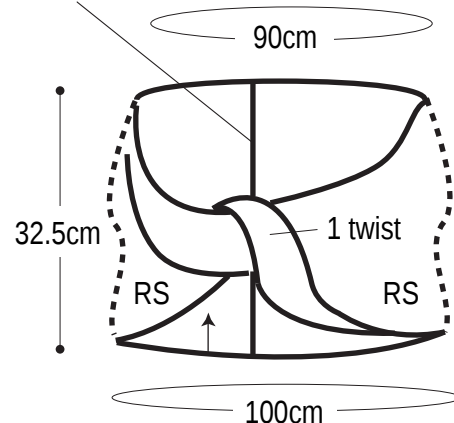
BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
RS = right side  
WS = wrong side
