218w-11 Bicolor Mitts



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Chuboso / Pure Wool Fingering [40% merino wool, 60% punta wool; 180 yds/165m per 1.4 oz./40g skein];
 - color #423 mustard, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #436 ecru beige, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 21/2) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 wooden beads (15mm/0.6" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 20cm/7.9"
- length 25.5cm/10.0"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch & pattern stitch: 28 sts and 33.5 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Summary

❖Note: Refer to schematics for color changes.

Body of mitt: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Continue in st st and pattern stitch. Work thumbhole stitches on waste yarn. After working 42 rounds, place back of hand stitches on stitch holder(s) and continue working palm stitches. Cast on new stitches for mitten flap using backwards loop cast-on increase and join into the round. Work in st st and k1p1 ribbing according to schematic. Go back and pick up stitches for back of hand. Continue and cast on new stitches for mitten flap using backwards loop cast-on increase and join into the round. Shape tips of mitts by decreasing according to schematic & chart. Seam tip of mitts using Kitchener stitch.


Thumb: Remove waste yarn from thumb stitches, placing the live stitches back on the needles. Work thumb in st st according to chart & schematic. After working final round, cut yarn and thread the tail through all remaining stitches; cinch top of thumb shut. Repeat for other thumb.

Finishing: Align the section of new sts on back of hand with the section marked with ★. Seam on wrong side with whipstitch such that seam isn't visible on right side. Crochet a button loop where indicated. Sew button to back of hand where indicated.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off ch = chain stitch CO = cast on k = knit OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) p = purl PU = pick up st st = stockinette stitch
